



# HOW TO MAKE UP AN ABSENCE

You can make up a **class** absences by doing a make-up assignment.

Make-up assignments **do not** count towards making up any General Sessions, Retreats, or other Confirmation events.

**There are 2 ways you can complete a make-up assignment:**  
using FORMED.org, or the brown textbook "The Catholic Faith Handbook".

## **If you would like to use FORMED.org, you can:**

1. Find 1-2 resources on Formed.org, that relates to the class topic of that week.
2. Write 1-2 thorough paragraphs summarizing what you learned.
3. Write 1 paragraph on your thoughts/reaction/experiences to this topic, as well as what you learned about this topic.
4. Cite the resources you found.

## **If you would like to utilize the brown textbook, you can:**

1. Read the chapter that covers the topic of that week.
2. Write a brief summary of the chapter.
3. Write 1 paragraph on your thoughts/reaction/experiences to this topic, as well as what you learned about this topic.
4. Answer the questions found in the back of the chapter in complete sentences.

### **FOR EXAMPLE:**

The 9/26 week covered Salvation History.  
You can find resources on FORMED.org, **or** find the chapter in your textbook that covers Salvation History, and then complete the assignment.
